

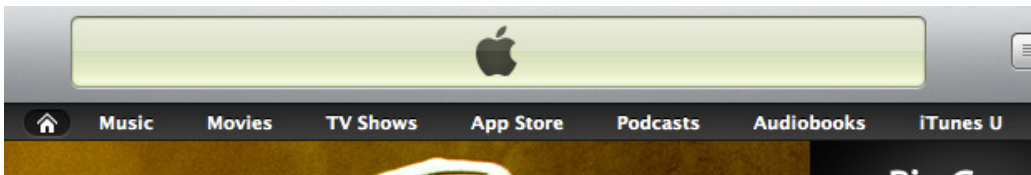
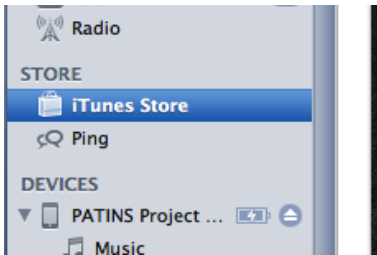
## ePubs to iPads

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS THROUGH FIRST.

Install iTunes if not already available on your computer. Do not use the iTunes connection on the iPad. You can find the latest version here:

Open iTunes and go to the iTunes store.

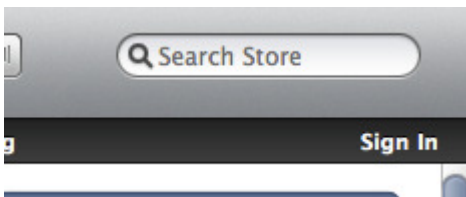


You will need to create an iTunes account if you don't already have one.

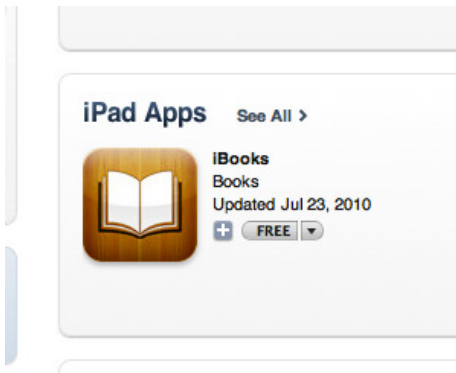

Sign in to your iTunes account



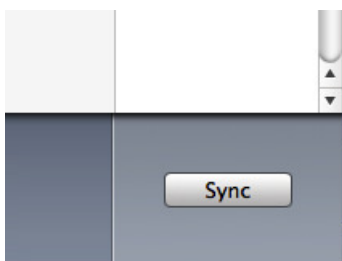
From the Apps Store you will need to download the free app “iBooks”.



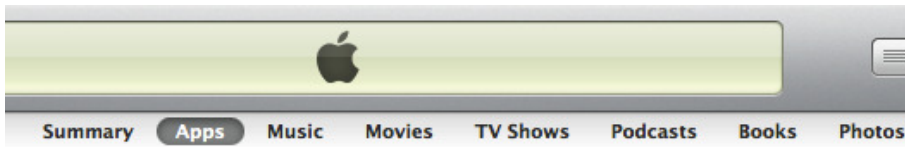
It will download and be placed in your iTunes Apps library.

Depending on how your iTunes and iPad are configured when connect, syncing may start automatically or you may have to sync it manually.

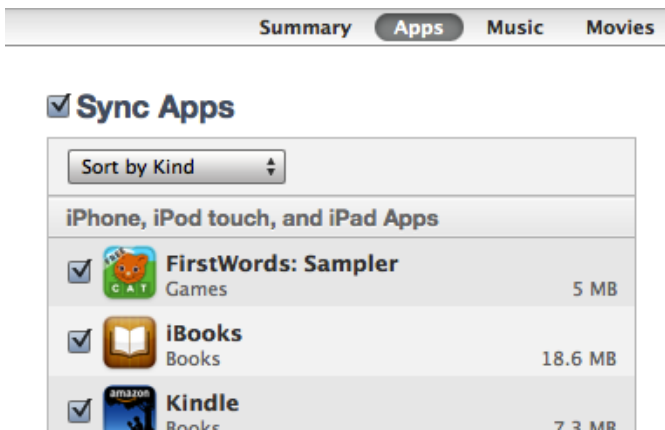
If your iPad is set to sync manually, connect your iPad, select your device from the left pane and Sync to iTunes. This will install the iBooks app onto your iPad.



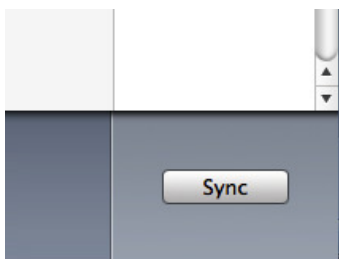
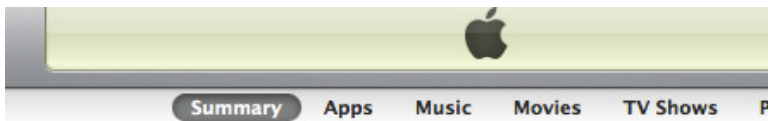
Once installed, click on the Apps tab at the top of the iPad window.



Make sure that the “Sync Apps” and “iBooks” boxes are checked.



Click on “Summary” at the top of the page and click “Sync” in the lower right corner.



On your iPad, you should now have an iBooks icon on your iPad. If you tap it, it will open to an empty bookcase.

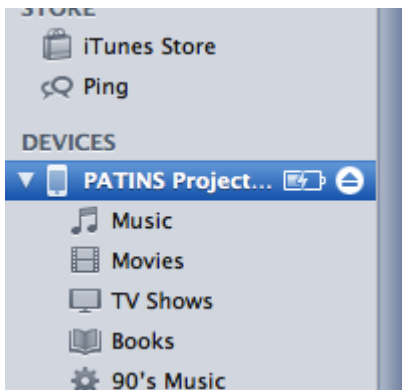
Now to upload the ePub....

Download and unseal the ePub to the computer Desktop. This will put a folder on your desktop containing the ePub files.

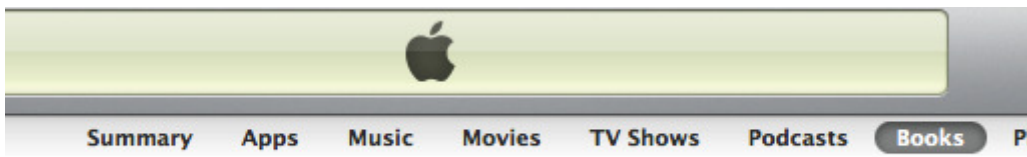
Open iTunes.

Connect the iPad

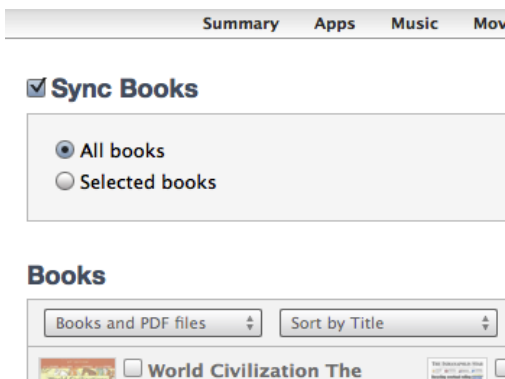
Once the iPad has synced, click on the iPad's name in the left pane of iTunes to bring up the Summary window.



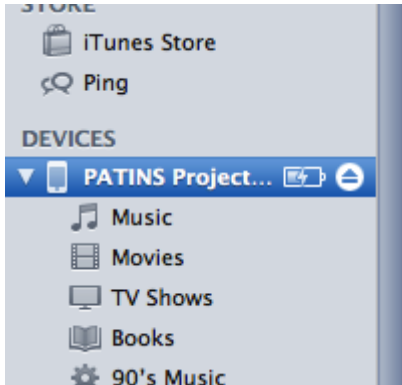
At the top of the iPad window is a tab named "Books"



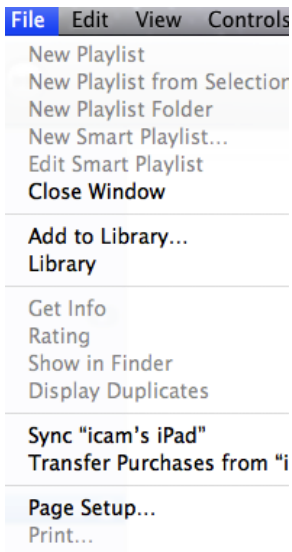
Click on the "Books" tab and check "Sync Books". You can choice here to have all books sent to the iPad or only select ones sent.



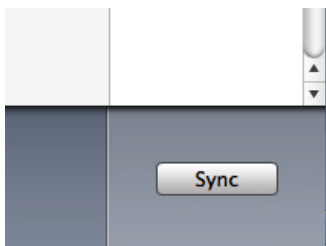
From your Desktop, open the folder which was created from the unsealing. The only file necessary is the ePub file, click and drag the ePub file onto your iPad in the iTunes window under devices.



OR you can click on “File”, “Add to Library “ and navigate to your desktop, select the ePub file and click “OK”. It will be added to your library.



Once copied, click the “Sync” button in the lower right corner of iTunes.



When the sync is complete you should find the ePub on the shelf of the iBook library of the iPad.

NOTE: You may want to create a folder to store your ePubs in other than the Desktop in which case substitute your folder location for the Desktop location.
